



## Mature Student Policy

Students over 21 who have **not** successfully completed grade 12 (or equivalent) may be considered for admission under the mature student policy. Requirements are as follows:

- Transcript proving minimum of grade 10. If the prospective student does not have Grade 10 from a recognized institution, the college will administer the Canadian Adult Achievement Test (CAAT) to determine grade 10 equivalency.
- A resume indicating prior educational and work history
- A letter of intent
- Three references
- Interview
- Differential Aptitude Test (This is a requirement for all applicants to the 12 week programs college but may be necessary for entrance to a 6 week program)
